A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO ENSURE PUBLIC SAFETY BY PROVIDING ADEQUATE LEVELS OF POLICE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the governments of the City of Miami Springs and the City of Doral, to ensure the public safety of their citizens by providing adequate levels of police services to address any foreseeable routine or emergency situation; and

WHEREAS, because of the existing and continuing possibility of the occurrence of law enforcement problems and other natural and man-made conditions which are, or are lively to be, beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, or facilities of the City of Miami Springs Police Department or the City of Doral Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City Council approve a Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Miami Springs and the City of Doral, Florida to ensure public safety by providing adequate levels of police services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Mutual Aid Agreement between the City of Miami Springs and the City of Doral, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference, is hereby approved, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney. The prior agreement with the City of Miami Springs took effect in 2019 and expired on April 1, 2024. The agreement currently

under consideration extends mutual aid between the City of Doral and the City of Miami Springs until 2029. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Mutual Aid Agreement on behalf of the City subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
