

**Whereas,** after completing his formal education, Javier Milei embarked upon a distinguished career in the private sector, commencing as an economist at HSBC Argentina, one of the nation's foremost financial institutions, where he contributed his expertise to the analysis and forecasting of economic trends;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei assumed the pivotal role of head economist at Máxima AFJP, a significant private pension fund established in the 1990s under the auspices of then-economy minister Domingo Cavallo, playing a crucial part in managing Argentina's social security system until its transition to state control in 2008;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei furthered his professional trajectory by joining Corporación América in 2008, a leading conglomerate under the stewardship of billionaire Eduardo Eurnekian, where he served as an economist and financial analyst, contributing his insights to diverse sectors including energy, infrastructure, agribusiness, and the management of Argentina's airports;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei's dedication to advancing economic discourse extended to his roles as the chief economist at Fundación Acordar, a distinguished think tank committed to promoting economic development and policy research, and as a university professor, imparting knowledge and fostering critical thinking among students;

**Whereas,** acknowledging his earlier association with Antonio Bussi, a former general implicated in Argentina's Dirty War (1976–1983), during Bussi's term as governor of Tucumán province, Javier Milei's career trajectory evolved to encompass his emergence as an influential television pundit in the mid-2010s, where he fervently discussed economic and political matters, often in colorful and confrontational terms;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei's incisive critique of successive presidential administrations, along with his theatrical and flamboyant style, propelled him to heightened prominence and popularity,

exemplified by his increasingly frequent appearances on television and radio shows, where he captivated audiences with his blend of entertainment and indignation;

**Whereas,** buoyed by his growing public profile and encouraged by supporters, Javier Milei transitioned into politics in 2021, founding the La Libertad Avanza coalition and securing election to the Chamber of Deputies, representing the city of Buenos Aires, where he continued to captivate attention through unconventional actions such as raffling off his salary to supporters on social media;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei's entry into the political arena marked a significant departure from conventional norms, as he positioned himself as a radical outsider, articulating a platform characterized by sweeping reforms and bold policy proposals, including the replacement of the national currency with the U.S. dollar and the downsizing of government ministries, advocating for a fundamental overhaul of Argentina's economic and political landscape;

**Whereas,** Javier Milei's unexpected success in the 2023 presidential primaries, where he emerged as a formidable contender, underscored the widespread discontent among the electorate and the resonance of his anti-establishment message, setting the stage for a fiercely contested general election and signaling a potential shift in Argentina's political landscape.
