Subject: Request to Execute pilot program agreement with "PADL" for Kayak

Kiosks

Introduction

The Parks and Recreation Department, respectfully requests the approval from the Mayor and City Councilmembers to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with PADL for a one (I) year pilot program to provide kayak kiosks at Doral Central Park & Doral Glades Park.

Background

Doral Central Park and Doral Glades Park promote nature and water recreation activities with the lakes located at each park such as fishing and kayaking. With the opening and addition of Doral Central Park, there has been an increased request from residents and visitors to use the park's kayak launch and kayak on the lake, however, most do not have access to kayaks. The Parks & Recreation Department partnered with the YMCA over the summer to offer a kayak program at Doral Glades Park, which was well received by residents with most Saturday sessions being sold out. The department reached out to the YMCA to see if they could offer monthly kayaking sessions at Doral Central Park, however, they are unable to provide services due to staffing shortages.

To provide access to kayaks for residents to use at the park, staff researched kayak rental vendor options. There are various vendors that have free standing kiosks that allow residents to rent and use kayaks. Below is summary chart comparing vendors:

PADL is the recommended vendor as there are no upfront or on-going costs required for the City to pay. PADL currently has agreements with other cities in South Florida to operate, including Miami Beach, City of Miami and City of Hollywood as well as other locations throughout central, west and north Florida. PADL also does not require a minimum contract term. With so many locations throughout the Miami-Dade area, our Doral parks will also be included on their app and website, allowing users to find our parks, that may not previously know about them, bringing more visitors to Doral and our parks. All equipment will be maintained and regularly checked by PADL and all users must sign a liability waiver and wear a lifejacket, provided with the kayak rental. Kayaks available will be both single and tandem (two person) kayaks.

Procurement

PADL was awarded an agreement for kayak rental services with Clay County, Florida via RFP No.23/24-068. They were also awarded RFP No. 20/21-7 in 2021. PADL also operates under an agreement with Miami Beach which was awarded via a bid waiver in 2021 for a period of two (2) years with three (3) additional one (1) year renewals. The second renewal was executed in August 2024. The City of Hollywood adopted the initial Clay County agreement.

Fiscal Impact

This item has no fiscal impact to the City. The are no expenses to the City and the City will receive 20% of revenue generated by PADL for the use of the kiosks at Doral park facilities.

PADL will provide data on revenue generated and usage which will be provided to the City on a monthly basis.

Recommendation

The City Manager's Office respectfully requests the approval from the Mayor and City Councilmembers to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with PADL for a one (I) year pilot program to provide kayak kiosks at Doral Central Park and Doral Glades Park.
