

RESOLUTION No. 25-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, COMMITTING THE CITY OF DORAL TO PROVIDE A 20% LOCAL MATCH CONTRIBUTION TO FUND THE COMPREHENSIVE SAFETY ACTION PLAN IF AWARDED BY THE SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) COMPETITIVE GRANT PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is committed to improving road safety, reducing traffic-related fatalities and injuries, and ensuring a transportation system that supports the well-being and economic prosperity of families and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) established the SS4A Grant Program, provided \$5 billion in funding through 2026 to support the National Roadway Safety Strategy, aiming for zero deaths and serious injuries through a Safe System Approach; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2025, the Mayor and City Councilmembers approved Resolution No. 25-79, launching a citywide Vision Zero initiative to eliminate traffic fatalities and serious injuries on City roadways and committing to apply for funding to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has yet to develop a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan for the implementation of the “*Vision Zero*” program; and

WHEREAS, SS4A funding is awarded competitively to projects with significant local or regional impact; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is seeking \$300,000.00 from the SS4A Grant to develop a citywide Comprehensive Safety Action Plan which will guide strategic safety improvements and create a transportation network that enhances public safety for all ages and abilities, and fosters economic opportunities; and

WHEREAS, to proceed with the application and maintain grant eligibility, the SS4A Grant requires the City to commit to a 20% local match contribution, in order to be in compliance with the funding requirements established in the FY 2025 SS4A Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO);

WHEREAS, if awarded the SS4A Grant, the City of Doral commits to provide the required 20% local match contribution to develop the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Council hereby approves funding the 20% required local match contribution to develop the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan as required by the SS4A Grant.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to commit to funding the 20% required local match contribution to develop the Comprehensive Safety Action Plan as required by the SS4A Grant as outlined in this Resolution.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
