A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$60,000.00 FROM ACCOUNT No. 001.60005.500641 TO ACCOUNT No. 001.60005.500640 TO ACCESS AND UTILIZE THE EXISTING NASPO VALUEPOINT AGREEMENT No. 23026 PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY OF DORAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR THE PURCHASE OF RUGGED LAPTOP COMPUTERS FROM UNITED DATA TECHNOLOGIES, INC. OR ANY OTHER AUTHORIZED CONTRACT RESELLERS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction:

The Police Department is seeking approval from the Mayor and City Council members for a budget transfer to allow the purchase of police rugged laptops utilizing the existing agreement between United Data Technologies, Inc. (authorized contract reseller) and Naspo ValuePoint Master Agreement No. 23026 (Resolution No. 25-242) in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds.

Background:

The Police Department is requesting approval to purchase rugged laptops to provide the officers with key information such as: real time dispatching which includes but not limited to, up to date narrative information, subject and vehicle description, which are paramount to the officer's safety when responding to a call. The laptops are being purchased for the current growth of the Department and the added positions for fiscal year 26-27.

This purchase will be funded from the budget transfer of \$60,000.00 from Capital Outlay Vehicles- Account number 001.60005.500641 to Capital Outlay Other- Account number 001.60005.500640.
