City of Doral Independence Day Celebration Event, Trump National Doral

On July 4, 2024, the City of Doral hosted its annual 4th of July Fireworks Event at the Trump National Doral located at 4400 NW 87th Avenue. The event was coordinated by the City of Doral Parks and Recreation Department and the DPD provided security and traffic control for this Independence Day Celebration. The DPD provided security and vehicular and pedestrian traffic control throughout the event.

City of Doral Independence Day Celebration Event, Doral Glades Park

The City of Doral provided a second location for residents to enjoy an Independence Day Celebration from the comfort of their own homes. On July 4, 2024, the City of Doral launched a spectacular 20-minute firework display from Doral Glades Park. The DPD was present and assisted the Doral Parks and Recreation Department by providing security and traffic direction during the event.

Trump Presidential Campaign Rally

The DPD was tasked with implementing a plan to provide security, crowd control, and traffic assistance during a Presidential Campaign Rally for Presidential Candidate Donald J. Trump at the Trump National Doral Resort, located at 4400 NW 87 Avenue on July 9, 2024. The event was expected to host approximately 15,000 to 20,000 supporters on the golf course's 10th hole fairway. The primary focus of the DPD was to protect life and property, to maintain order, and provide for the expeditious flow of traffic around the event venue. The DPD collaborated with our local, state, and federal partners to ensure safe and successful event which concluded without incident.

Citizens Police Academy #16

The Citizens Police Academy is a great opportunity for residents and business owners to acquaint themselves with an overview of the day-to-day operations of the DPD. The Citizens Police Academy offers the community a greater perspective and enhances the participants' knowledge of the partnership with law enforcement and community they serve.
