Subject: Revision to Maximum Fee for Immobilization of Vehicles

Introduction

In 2017, the City of Doral adopted Ordinance 2017 – 14, which created a regulation on the immobilization of vehicles on private properties. Subsequently, Resolution 17-228 set the maximum fee for the immobilization of vehicles on private property at \$25.00.

Recommendation

Since 2017, the City has experienced unprecedented growth. This growth has led to an increase in the enforcement of illegal parking on private property of patrons visiting the City's popular retail establishments. Additionally, the nation has seen an increase in the rate of inflation. Taking into consideration these facts, it is necessary that the City revisit the maximum fee imposed on the immobilization of vehicles illegally parked on private property.

It is recommended that the fee be increased to \$75.00.
