National Night Out

On August 6, 2024, the City of Doral celebrated National Night Out and our annual Back to School Event held at Doral Legacy Park. National Night Out is a nation-wide community building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships. This event is celebrated across all fifty states and for Doral PD, it was another great opportunity for us to connect with members of the community and share information about back-to-school safety and distribute school supplies and giveaways from community partners and discuss safety awareness and crime prevention techniques.

Doral Police Blitz Detail

Electronic Message Boards were also deployed in strategic areas to remind pedestrians and drivers to be alert and drive safe in our school zones.
