Subject: Response to Revised Resolution Establishing Limitations on the Rotating Vice Mayor Position

Introduction

This memorandum provides a staff analysis of the Revised Resolution Establishing Limitations on the Rotating Vice Mayor Position.

Background

On December 18, 2024, the Mayor and City Council adopted Resolution 24-273, establishing guidelines for the Vice Mayor position. The City Charter specifies that the Vice Mayor role rotates annually among Councilmembers. The revised resolution seeks to clarify how the title is used in City materials to ensure consistency and cost-efficiency in official communications

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of this resolution may vary annually based on factors such as office branding preferences, stationary needs, active construction projects requiring new signage, and marketing initiatives. Below is a table summarizing some examples of potential costs:
