Project Management

Project Overview

The ""DORAL SHINES, Unity in Diversity" initiative aims to create a large-scale artwork that reflects Doral's essence, including its tagline "Doral Shines" and themes of family, unity, peace, and multiculturalism.

This project will engage local residents in the artistic process, fostering connections, understanding, and appreciation among different cultural groups. The completed artwork will be painted in a Doral Central park Water Tank, serving as a lasting symbol of community unity.

Which would be a visual experience that not only adds to the sense of place as you enter Doral Central Park, but, reflects the neighborhood and the community

Objectives

Cultural Representation: To highlight the various cultural backgrounds present in our community through art.

Community Engagement: To involve residents of all ages in the creation process, promoting collaboration and dialogue.

Public Art Installation: To produce a durable public artwork that will beautify the community and serve as a landmark for inclusivity.

Art Education: To provide workshops that educate participants on Street art techniques and the importance of art in cultural expression.

Target Audience

Local residents, including families, youth, seniors, and diverse cultural groups.

Local schools and educational institutions.

Community organizations and non-profits focused on cultural diversity and art.

Technique:

Mixed media

Spray paint, stencils, Brush Paint, Street art markers

Spray Brand to use in the project:

Fast drying, Very good resistance to the sun and rain. Very good resistance to UV light

Brush Paint Brand to use in the project:

BEHR Premium plus Paint and Primer

Total area to be painted: (7800 Sqf aprox)

Timeline

Due to the size of the water tank area (7800 Sqf aprox) and the artist's design, the estimated time to paint the mural could be between 2 and 3 months.

Project Planning (January 20-25 2025)

Finalize design, secure permits, select colors.

Beginning of the nighttime projection of the mural design. (January 27 -February 7 2025)

For this activity, it is necessary to obtain a permit for the artist and his assistants to be on site overnight.

Beginning of Painting Mural. (February 3 2025)

Once the mural is finished, a protective layer should be applied to the entire surface. The estimated timeline for this task would be one week.





The Artist

Eduardo Sanabria (EDO)

Venezuelan- American plastic artist, residing in Miami. EDO has been investigating the phenomenon of mass culture and Pop culture for more than 20 years. His works have been exhibited in Caracas, Paris, Milan, Madrid, Seoul, Shanghai, Tokyo, Chicago, New York, Las Vegas and Miami.

Along with his historical work and his successful new explorations in contemporary Ibero-American art, EDO has been growing in reputation as an international urban artist. He has been invited to create four (4) murals in Wynwood, one of the most important art districts in the United States, the annual home of ArtBasel Miami Beach. It is the place par excellence for elite, world-class artists, gallery owners, and cultural institutions.

Timeless Influencers

One of the fascinating sociological angles of this series of works by EDO has been to imagine and recreate what great personalities from universal history would have been like if they had access to the powerful technological tools enjoyed by current influencers. Thus, his series "Timeless Influencers" was born.

Based on this concept, he painted two murals: "Frida Influencer" (2022) and "Warhol Influencer" (2024), both at the **Art Center Miami Gallery in Wynwood.**






The Beach Art Tunnel / Aruba
