SPECIAL DETAILS AND EVENTS

Aggressive Driving Unit

On February 3, 2025, the DPD proudly unveiled the Aggressive Driving Unit (ADU) at the Doral Police Headquarters surrounded by our supportive Mayor, Elected Officials, City Manager, and DPD personnel. ADU will be housed in our Special Operations Bureau which is comprised of our Motors Unit, K9 Unit, and School Resource Officer Unit. ADU will focus on strategic enforcement initiatives to combat city-wide speeding, school zone and parking violations; commercial vehicle violations and high traffic area control; DUI enforcement details and intersection takeovers. ADU will also provide police presence in all our parks and “green spaces,” engaging with our community while protecting those enjoying all that the City of Doral has to offer. The DPD continues to have zero tolerance against these violations and will continue to allocate resources to safeguard our city.

Touch a Truck Event

On February 3, 2025, the DPD participated in and provided police presence at the 3rd Annual Touch a Truck event at Miami International Mall. This event was a great opportunity for all to get an up-close look at a variety of trucks such as: fire trucks, construction vehicles, and our DPD Community on Patrol vehicle.

Camping Under the Stars Event

On February 7, 2025, the City of Doral celebrated its annual Camping Under the Stars event at Doral Central Park. This event was a wonderful opportunity for participants to enjoy the outdoors and camp overnight around a bonfire while participating in family-friendly events. The DPD joined the community and provided a safe environment for all.

Remembering Marjory Stoneman Douglas (MSD)

Friday, February 14, 2025, marked the seven-year anniversary of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas mass school shooting incident. The DPD implemented a plan to facilitate a safe school day for the students and families attending schools in Doral. The plan assigned DPD officers to traffic details during specified times to assist during inbound and outbound school traffic, and increased visibility throughout the day in our schools. DPD uniformed officers were strategically deployed to schools

within their assigned areas in marked police vehicles with overhead lights for enhanced visibility and to promote officer and community safety.

Coffee with a Cop Events

February 13 and 26, 2025, the DPD participated in two coffee and conversation events at Macondo Coffee Roasters and Sergio's Restaurant. These events are an ideal opportunity for members of the DPD, City of Doral Leadership and members of the community to share their ideas and get to know one another better.

Doral Police Honor Guard Detail

On February 18, 2025, the Miami-Dade State Attorney's Office celebrated the investiture ceremony of the Honorable Katherine Fernandez-Rundle, where she renewed her Oath of Office. DPD Honor Guard participated in a multi-agency Honor Guard detail and joined members from neighboring agencies and municipalities.

Protective Detail with United States Secret Service (USSS)

On February 20, 2025, the DPD assisted our Federal partners and USSS with the visit security and traffic assistance of the President of the United States to Trump National Doral Resort. The Department's preparations and planning resulted in a successful conference which concluded without any major incidents reported.

Pedaling Through the Community Bicycle Event

On February 20, 2025, sworn members from all ranks and assignments united to conduct a City-wide bicycle ride and connected with members of the community. They rode through Downtown Doral and Downtown Doral Elementary, City Place, Doral Academy Elementary, Trump National Doral Resort, and many residential and business areas along the way for a total of 11 miles.

On Tuesday, February 25, 2025, the DPD completed a Narcotics Destruction of 300 approved items which met the criteria per Florida State Statutes, Title XL, Chapter 893.12.
