

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PILOT PROGRAM AGREEMENT WITH MUNICIPAL PARKING SERVICES, INC. FOR THE EVALUATION OF SAFETYSTICK PROHIBITED PARKING ENFORCEMENT TECHNOLOGY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE PILOT PROGRAM AGREEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral continually evaluates emerging technologies to improve transportation, parking management, curb management, public safety, and operational efficiency throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Parking Services, Inc. ("MPS") has offered to provide the City with a 30-day pilot program of its SafetyStick Prohibited Parking Enforcement Technology Platform, which includes high-definition camera systems, automated license plate recognition technology, cloud-based management software, reporting tools, and related communications infrastructure for evaluation purposes only; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Pilot Program will allow the City to evaluate the effectiveness, reliability, operational efficiency, and planning capabilities of automated prohibited parking monitoring technology while supporting the City's parking and mobility objectives and data-driven decision-making initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the Pilot Program will be conducted solely for evaluation and testing purposes, will not result in any financial obligation to the City, and does not obligate the City to purchase, lease, procure, or otherwise acquire any equipment or services from MPS following completion of the Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed Pilot Program Agreement, MPS shall furnish, install, operate, maintain, monitor, train City personnel, and remove all Pilot equipment at its sole expense, and the City shall incur no costs associated with the Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, the Pilot Program Agreement further provides that parking citations shall not be issued, mailed, or processed by MPS as part of the Pilot Program, and any future deployment of such technology would require separate consideration and approval by the City in accordance with applicable procurement requirements and Florida law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that participation in the proposed Pilot Program serves a valid public purpose by allowing the City to evaluate innovative parking technologies that may improve parking compliance, operational efficiency, data collection, and future transportation planning; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully recommend approval of the Pilot Program Agreement between the City of Doral and Municipal Parking Services, Inc., attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Pilot Program Agreement between the City of Doral and Municipal Parking Services, Inc. for the evaluation of the SafetyStick Prohibited Parking Enforcement Technology Platform, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Pilot Agreement on behalf of the City. The City Manager is further authorized to execute any necessary documents and take any action necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the Pilot Agreement.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
