BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Doral plays a vital role in offering quality sports programming and events that promote active lifestyles, social engagement, inclusion, and well-being for residents of all ages. Current structured programming includes popular sports such as tennis, soccer, and pickleball, which serve a broad range of community needs.

Volleyball has become an increasingly popular sport in Doral, with many residents participating recreationally and competitively through school teams and local clubs.
