ITEM TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE III, "BOARDS, COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS," IN CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION," OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; REVISING THE SUNSET PROVISION AND APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

Since the inception of the City of Doral, the City Council has created, from time to time, various advisory boards, committees, and commissions to advise and support the City Council in the development of policies, programs, projects, and events in a variety of subject areas for the benefit of the City.

The City Charter was amended in November 5, 2024 to provide that boards, committee and commissions be comprised of five members, and that the Mayor and Councilmembers shall each appoint one member to each board. The City's Code was later amended to reflect the appointment of the alternate members by the Mayor.
