City of Doral SS4A Narrative

The City of Doral is an urban community in Miami-Dade County, Florida, with one of the highest population growth rates in the county. As more people make Doral its home or place of work, the city the streets are becoming increasingly congested with vehicles and freight, intensifying transportation challenges. Amid this surge, the most vulnerable road users, pedestrians and bicyclists, face alarming risks when navigating the city. According to the city's Transportation Master Plan (2024), pedestrians and bicyclists represent 19% of fatal and serious injury (FSI) crashes, despite accounting for only 1% of total crashes. This disparity underscores the *urgent need for a Comprehensive Safety Action Plan (CSAP)* that applies to a strategic, data-driven approach to roadway safety.

The city's underserved communities lie just south of a bustling industrial park, where relentless noise pollution and heavy truck traffic pose ongoing challenges. While the city has proactively established designated "non-thru truck routes" within its boundaries, the high volume of trucks continues to impact vulnerable road users, raising serious concerns about public safety. Despite efforts to mitigate these risks, pedestrians and bicyclists still face hazardous conditions, underscoring the need for further action to ensure safer and more accessible streets.

With an average annual fatality rate of 2.3 per 100,000 residents, the city's Transportation Master Plan has recorded 103 fatalities and severe injuries over the past eight years. For this hardworking community, where 82% of the population is Hispanic, the need for safer roadways is undeniable. Developing a CSAP will be a crucial step toward protecting lives and fostering a safer, more accessible city for all users.

In March 2025, the City Council passed Resolution No. 25-6092, establishing Doral's Vision Zero goal to eliminate traffic fatalities and severe injuries on city roadways by 2040. Achieving this ambitious objective requires the development of the CSAP, a critical blueprint for safer streets. The proposed CSAP is set to begin in April 2026, with the goal of final adoption by October 2027. The plan will conduct a thorough analysis of existing crash data and trends, ensuring a data-driven approach to safety improvements. Additionally, it will prioritize bilingual community engagement and targeted public education campaigns, particularly in neighborhoods near freight hubs where risks are amplified. Once implemented, the CSAP will serve as a vital tool in creating a safer, more accessible city, ensuring that vulnerable road users can navigate Doral's streets safely.
