



CITY OF DORAL COUNCIL MEETING MEMORANDUM

ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID PROCESS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-321 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI TABLE TENNIS CLUB FOR THE PROVISION OF TABLE TENNIS PROGRAMMING AT DORAL LEGACY PARK RESPECTIVELY FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR WITH FOUR (4) ONE (1) YEAR RENEWALS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION:

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Parks and Recreation Department respectfully requests approval from the Mayor and City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Miami Table Tennis Club for Table Tennis Programming. Miami Table Tennis Club will continue offering their services at Doral Legacy Park.

Miami Table Tennis (originally named Doral Table Tennis Club), entered into a pilot program agreement with the City of Doral on October 1, 2019, to offer Table Tennis Programming at Doral Legacy Park. This program was highly successful during the six months of this pilot program prior to the shutdown from the pandemic and community centers closing.

Following RFP #2021-01 Miami Table Tennis was awarded by Council (Res.21-89) during the April 14, 2021 council meeting to enter into an agreement with the City for a period of three (3) years with two (2) one (1) year renewal options. The agreement was signed on May 18, 2021, as community centers were beginning to reopen. There was a notice to proceed document signed on June 10, 2021, for Miami Table Tennis to begin offering their program once again at Doral Legacy Park's community center beginning June 14, 2021.

There were renewal options executed in 2024 and again in 2025. Their agreement is now expiring on June 14, 2026, with no remaining renewal options on their current agreement.

This program is extremely successful with a consistent following. The classes are well attended and has been a positive in the community with an average registration of 20 per month.

The Parks & Recreation Department respectfully requests waiver of the competitive bid process pursuant to section 2-321 of the City Code of Ordinances and allow the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Miami Table Tennis Club to continue offering Table Tennis Programming at Doral Legacy Park for a period of one (1) year with four (4) additional one (1) year renewals.
