ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR ACCESS TO FCIC/NCIC VIA MIAMI-DADE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND THE CITY OF DORAL THROUGH ITS DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAINING ACCESS TO INFORMATION SYSTEMS THAT PROVIDE CRITICAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE DATA AT BOTH THE STATE AND NATIONAL LEVEL; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS, PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Police Department respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council Members authorize the Police Department to enter an Interagency Agreement for Access to FCIC/NCIC via Miami-Dade Sheriff's Office and the City of Doral through its Doral Police Department.

The Doral Police Department will be entitled to use, through agents and employees of the Miami Dade Sheriff's Office, the computer system provided via the MDSO for the purpose of gaining access to the FCIC (Florida Crime Information Center) and NCIC (National Crime Information Center), Law Enforcement Interface Systems (LEIS), Electronic Arrest Form (e A-Form), and the Miami-Dade CJS System which is essential for police departments to access critical criminal justice data at both the state and national levels. These systems provide real-time information on wanted persons, missing individuals, stolen property, protective orders, and criminal history. Authorized personnel, such as officers, detectives, and dispatchers, use these systems during traffic stops, investigations, arrests, and dispatch operations. The systems are often integrated with CAD, RMS, and mobile data terminals, ensuring secure and efficient information flow.
