BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Doral last revised its Telecommunication on Rights of Way Ordinance in 2008. In 2019, the State of Florida passed sweeping legislation that removed many rights of local governments to regulate telecommunication infrastructure on rights of way. However, this legislation did prescribe the manner in which local governments through local legislation could regulate distance placement, permit process, application, and aesthetics. The proposed legislation updates the City’s current ordinance and strengthens the City’s ability to regulate the placement of telecommunication on the City’s Rights of Way.
