

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS FOR RECURRING ANNUAL MAINTENANCE FEE FOR PORTABLE RADIOS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 24-276 authorized the City Manager to utilize the NASPO 00318 Cooperative Purchasing Agreement negotiated with Motorola by the State of Washington Department of Enterprise Service to expend funds for the purchase of NEXT Single-band portable radios; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the Mayor and City Council Members authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Motorola Solutions for the recurring annual maintenance cost for the amount budgeted each fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City's Code of Ordinances, the governmental contract and related cooperative procurement requirements for Motorola Solutions' annual maintenance costs for each fiscal year, for a term of up to five (5) years, are hereby approved. These funds will be allocated from the IT Repair and Maintenance- Office Equipment Account #001.22005.500464 or other most appropriate account(s) as approved in the budget.

Section 3. Authorization: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Motorola Solutions for annual maintenance costs for the amount budgeted each fiscal year for a period of up to five (5) years (26-27, 27-28, 28-29, 29-30, and 30-31).

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council’s intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
