ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES, ADOPTING THE EXISTING CONTRACT WITH GENERAC POWER SYSTEMS, INC. VIA SOURCEWELL CONTRACT No. 020923-GNR FOR THE PURCHASE OF A LIGHT TOWER AS WELL AS ANY OTHER EQUIPMENT, PRODUCTS AND/OR SERVICES AVAILABLE UNDER THE CONTRACT TERMS, WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY'S CODE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction:

The Police Department is seeking approval from the Mayor and City Council members to adopt and utilize the existing contract with Generac Power Systems Inc., via Sourcewell Contract No. 020923-GNR for the purchase of a light tower as well as any other equipment, products, or services available under the contract terms mentioned therein. The City is seeking a waiver of competitive bidding.

Background:

The Police Department is requesting approval to purchase a light tower, as well as any other equipment, products, or services available under the contract terms. The light tower is a critical public safety asset that provides high-intensity illumination during nighttime operations, emergency incidents, crime scene investigations, traffic accidents, search-and-rescue missions, and disaster response. Enhanced lighting improves officer safety, increases visibility for evidence collection and scene management, and helps protect the public by reducing hazards in low-light conditions. A dedicated light tower also allows the police department to respond more effectively to power outages, severe weather events, and large-scale community events, ensuring operational readiness and improving overall emergency response capabilities to the residents of the City of Doral.
