

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RENEW THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FOR FILM PERMITTING IN THE CITY OF DORAL FOR AN INITIAL FIVE-YEAR PERIOD, WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW ADMINISTRATIVELY FOR TWO (2) FIVE (5) YEAR PERIODS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Public Affairs Department serves as the City's liaison for film and still photography productions, coordinating with the Miami-Dade County Office of Film and Entertainment, City departments, and private partners to facilitate filming within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners passed Ordinance 91-50, in order to effect a one-stop permitting process within the Miami-Dade Office of Film and Entertainment; and the Ordinance allows for the County to enter into interlocal agreements with the various municipalities within Miami-Dade County in order for the Miami-Dade Film Office to permit for use of municipal property and services.; and

WHEREAS, as part of the City's Film Permitting Interlocal Agreement, Miami-Dade County has processed film permitting on behalf of Doral for the past ten years. The agreement is now up for renewal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute renewal of the Interlocal Agreement to continue work with Miami-Dade County for film and photography permits.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
