

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (TPO) FOR THE CITY TO RECEIVE SIXTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$61,000.00) IN GRANT FUNDING FOR THE DORAL ARTS DISTRICT - ADAPTIVE RE-USE MASTER PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in November of 2025, the Miami Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) requested ideas from municipalities for the funding of transportation planning projects for the FY 2026-2027 Municipal Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Grant Program is a competitive program which awards funds to municipalities for a variety transportation planning initiatives, including multimodal transportation studies, corridor analyses, master plans, and feasibility studies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") Public Works Department ("PWD") submitted an application requesting Sixty One Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$61,000.00) to fund the completion of the Doral Arts District - Adaptive Re-Use Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the TPO provided the attached Interlocal Agreement to the City to receive reimbursement funding in the amount of Sixty-One Thousand Dollars (\$61,000.00) for use in the development of the Doral Arts District - Adaptive Re-Use Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the TPO will reimburse the City a total amount of Sixty-One Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$61,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City will be responsible for a Two Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Dollar and 00/100 (\$239,000.00) local match; and

WHEREAS, the Doral Arts District - Adaptive Re-Use Master Plan will develop a conceptual plan for the necessary infrastructure improvements for the Adaptive Re-Use Area as a comprehensive Multimodal Streets Program that would provide better pedestrian connectivity and safety; and

WHEREAS, the TPO and the City's PWD wish to enter into an Interlocal Agreement substantially in the form of Exhibit "A" hereto attached (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that entering into the Interlocal Agreement is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The Interlocal Agreement with Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization for the City of Doral to receive funding in the amount of \$61,000.00 for use in the development of the Doral Arts District - Adaptive Re-Use Master Plan, subject to any non-substantial changes that are approved by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. City Manager is authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement as provided by the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as

necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
