orna Samara Ash was born in **Bogota, Colombia**; she lives & works in Miami, Florida. She is a resident artist at **FountainHead Studios**, Little River, Florida. Ash graduated as **Valedictorian** from The University of Florida through New World School of the Arts (2008) where she earned a Dual BFA in Painting and Electronic Intermedia along with a Minor in Art History.

Ash is an interdisciplinary artist that works across mediums to research power & frailty as a subject. Through her work, she creates a space for dialogue; often incorporating painting, photography, large-scale murals and tech into her practice; Ash draws inspiration from personal & historical experiences of potentiality & weakness.

Ash's work has been part of numerous exhibitions; selected shows include Unveiling: Art Basel Miami, Miami Shores Village Hall (2023); AWENA Inauguration, City of Fort Pierce (2023); Channing Tatum's: MML LIVE & Steven Soderbergh's Singani 63, Buick Building Design District, Miami, FL (2022), Sagamore The Art Hotel, South Beach, Florida (2010); Museum of Art & Design - Freedom Tower, Downtown Miami, Florida (2008), Broward-County Public Library, Ft. Lauderdale, Florida (2006), Finger Lakes GrassRoots of Music & Dance, Ithaca, New York (2019), The Lightbox at Goldman Warehouse, Wynwood, Florida (2015), and Fountainhead Studios Exhibit, Little River, Florida (2022).

Ash was the recipient of various awards including the Nall Art Association European Scholarship, Saint-Paul-de-Vence, France, Koubek Center Arts Residency, Little Havana, New World School of the Arts Full Scholarship, Downtown Miami, Siggraph Space-Time Competition winner, Los Angeles, California, The Mickey Wolfson Jr. Center Best Drawing Award, Miami, Florida, among others. As a professional muralist with over 25 years of experience, I've had the privilege of bringing vibrant, thought-provoking art to a wide array of public spaces. My journey in the arts has also led me to roles as an art project manager and art consultant, where I honed my ability to oversee and execute large-scale projects with precision and creativity.

This combination of hands-on artistic expertise and project management acumen uniquely positions me to contribute meaningfully to this project.



Explanation of Mural Concept and Overall Design

The mural, titled "Haven," draws inspiration from Doral's motto, "Premier place to live, work, learn & play" symbolizing that Doral is a true haven. The design centers on a mixed-race female figure representing the various ethnic groups that have lived in the area since the 80s. The female with striking red hair represents fearlessness & passion. She swims through pristine, crystalline waters (the water is reminiscent of rain water, of the Great Egret Lake, and of Lake Okeechobee flowing & feeding the everglades) creating an ethereal connection with the area's natural beauty. Sun rays (Doral Shines) filter through the water, illuminating the flora and fauna, and the presence of a bald eagle signifies wisdom, offering guidance to the figure.

A magenta-colored hibiscus flower symbolizes family love and longevity, while colorful fish dart playfully among underwater plants, evoking a sense of fun & harmony with nature. A larger yellow fish represents the community's unity and light blue accents remind viewers of the city's deep connection to water (the yellow & blue hues are those found in Doral's flag). The mural not only celebrates the natural wildlife of Florida but also honors the rich flora and fauna of Miami-Dade County, embracing the theme of transcendence, evolution, and the human experience as a "haven" is discovered.

Mural's Interactive Element

Augmented Reality murals turn passive observers into active participants, fostering ownership and responsibility for environmental stewardship. This project will inspire and educate the community to protect Florida's natural heritage. As viewers share their AR experiences on social media, the mural becomes a catalyst for raising awareness and sparking conversations.

Contribution to Doral & Community Engagement

This mural will be a vibrant addition to Doral, enhancing the public art scene and fostering community pride. Featuring local wildlife and natural elements, "Haven" connects Doral's history with its evolving identity, encouraging residents and visitors to reflect on the city's role as a haven of growth & creativity. Further, a community art event can be organized where residents can be invited to paint part of the artwork, creating ownership and strengthening community bonds.

Maintenance Requirements

The mural may require minimal touch-ups approximately every 2-5 years in areas that may fade or dim due to exposure to rain water.
