ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING A PARTNERSHIP WITH THE ALPHA 421 GROUP FOR A TEMPORARY BLACK BOX THEATRE AT THE DORAL CULTURAL ARTS CENTER FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF "THE WALLS HAVE EARS"/ "LAS PAREDES OYEN"; PROVIDING A TIMELINE FOR SET-UP AND PERFORMANCE DATES; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The Doral Cultural Art Center has been a cornerstone of artistic expression and community engagement in our city. As we strive to celebrate our diverse heritage, it is essential that we offer platforms that reflect the complex stories and experiences of our community members. The producers of the upcoming play "The Walls Have Ears," led by Miami native Robby Ramos, have recently received an anticommunist grant from the state. This grant will facilitate a cultural project that dives deep into the narratives surrounding Cuban political prisoners during the 1960s, which is a significant chapter in our shared history. Ramos, who draws on personal and familial experiences related to this historical context, brings a unique perspective to the production.

Importantly, Alpha 421 Group will provide free entry to students in Doral, and reduce rates for senior citizens.
