

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND THE CURRENT AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA RECREATIONAL SPORTS FOR SIX (6) MONTHS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Florida Recreational Sports entered into a program agreement with the City of Doral on July 19, 2021, to offer Competitive and Travel Baseball Programming at Doral Meadow Park. This program has been successful during the five (5) years with a maximum enrollment of Two Hundred Seventy Five (275) participants in Spring 2026; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RFP #2020-29 Florida Recreational Sports, who was the second ranked proposal, after negotiations failed with the top ranked proposal, Alex Otan, was awarded a contract to manage and operated a travel little league baseball program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 21-64 the Council authorized a term of three (3) years with two (2) one (1) year renewal options with Florida Recreational Sports, from the effective date; and

WHEREAS, the agreement was signed on July 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in 2024 and again in 2025, the agreement was renewed with an expiration of July 19, 2026; and

WHEREAS, currently there are no remaining extensions; and

WHEREAS, this little league baseball program has been extremely successful with a consistent following; and

WHEREAS, of interest, Florida Recreational Sports has even hosted teams and families from across South Florida in addition to their regular programming, which have been highly attended and successful; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 2-323(5) of the City Code, the City Manager's Office respectfully requests approval from the Mayor and City Councilmembers to authorize the City Manager to extend the agreement with Florida Recreational Sports to continue providing competitive and travel youth baseball for a period of six months ending January 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it in its best interests to continue the baseball programming provided by Florida Recreational Sports for a period of six months to allow consistency and continuity for the fall season under the same terms and conditions as the City renegotiates the current agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval & Authorization. The Mayor and City Councilmembers, pursuant to Sec. 2-323(5) of the City Code, the City Manager's Office respectfully requests approval from the Mayor and City Councilmembers to authorize the City Manager to extend the agreement with Florida Recreational Sports to continue providing competitive and travel baseball for a period of six (6) months on a revenue

share 85% / 15% split (85% Provider / 15% City) with the provider handling all registrations. The revenue split will be paid by the provider to the City and deposited into GL account 001.9000.347407 (Recreation Baseball).

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
