Operation Southern Slow Down

The DPD participated in Operation Southern Slow Down which is an annual, week-long speed enforcement and public education campaign conducted in partnership with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). This event, that ran from July 14 through July 19, 2025, aimed to reduce speed-related fatalities and serious injury crashes by targeting speeding and aggressive driving violation. The DPD Aggressive Driving Unit issued 757 total citations during this campaign which include: 158 speeding citations, 13 seat belt violations, 184 moving citations, and 3 arrests by members of the Traffic Unit.

Coffee with a Cop

On July 17, 2025, the DPD participated in a Coffee with a Cop event hosted by A Family Restaurant, an opportunity for members of the community to speak with our DPD Officers and continue to build our partnerships. These events bring all participating together for an opportunity to share in conversation with no agenda or speeches, just a chance to ask questions, voice concerns or simply get to know your local police officers better.

Back to School Preparation

With the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year, the DPD School Safety Section prepared a plan which encompasses an “all hands-on deck” back to school safety approach assigning DPD officers to traffic details at all City of Doral schools to facilitate inbound and outbound traffic as children are being dropped off and picked up. In addition, the DPD will be deploying electronic message boards in strategic areas throughout the city to emphasize safety to both pedestrians and drivers on back-to-school traffic awareness.

Parks and Police 4Kids (PP4K) Summer Camp

The PP4K Foundation collaborates with the DPD to offer a summer camp for children at our city’s newest park, Doral Central Park. The camp provides a variety of activities such as sports, teamwork, discipline, and empowers participants in a safe and empowering environment. The PP4K Summer Camp is led by DPD SROs who spend quality time with our youth and mentor them along the way!

Swearing-In Ceremony for Honorary Deputy Devarjaye “DJ” Daniel

On July 25, 2025, the DPD jointed the Miami-Dade Sheriff’s Office and other law enforcement agencies in the special swearing-in ceremony and recognition of “DJ” for his personal courage and support of law enforcement. DJ is a 13-year-old young man who is bravely battling brain and
