

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CITY OF DORAL HISTORICAL ARCHIVE TO PRESERVE AND EXHIBIT THE CITY'S ART PIECES, SIGNIFICANT HISTORICAL EVENTS, AND THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF ITS RESIDENTS; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO COORDINATE WITH THE CITY CLERK, LOCAL CULTURAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND RELEVANT DEPARTMENTS TO DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN THE ARCHIVE; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is a vibrant, diverse, and rapidly growing municipality with a distinctive cultural heritage, and it is a priority of this Council to ensure that the history, identity, and achievements of the City are preserved and accessible for current and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the preservation of cultural artifacts, public art pieces, documentation of foundational civic events, and the recorded histories of pioneering and notable residents are essential to fostering civic pride, a shared sense of community identity, and an enduring connection between Doral's past and its future; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a centralized, dedicated historical archive will serve as a lasting educational resource for schools, researchers, families, and visitors, showcasing Doral's evolution from its early development to its emergence as a premier global city, and will strengthen the City's capacity to tell its own story on its own terms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is fortunate to feature robust community spaces, including the upcoming state-of-the-art Miami-Dade Public Library System Doral Branch

Library and the City's award-winning parks network, which offer ideal collaborative opportunities for digital and physical historical exhibitions; and

WHEREAS, comparable municipalities across the State of Florida and the nation have successfully established municipal archives and historical preservation programs to safeguard their unique local histories, and the City of Doral seeks to implement recognized best practices in municipal cultural preservation to ensure that its own heritage receives the same institutional permanence; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral's unique demographic identity — shaped by generations of immigrants and families from across Latin America and the world who chose Doral as their home — represents a living history of aspiration, resilience, and community-building that deserves to be formally documented, honored, and shared; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find that authorizing the creation of the City of Doral Historical Archive serves a compelling public interest, advances the City's commitment to civic education and cultural stewardship, and will safeguard the cultural legacy of Doral for the lasting benefit of its residents.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council reaffirm their commitment to honoring the City's history and the people who shaped it, and find that the establishment of a formal City of Doral Historical Archive is a necessary and appropriate exercise of the City's municipal authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Authorization. The Mayor and City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorize and direct the creation of the City of Doral Historical Archive, to be dedicated to the collection, preservation, and public exhibition of historic art pieces, significant civic and cultural events, and biographical records of notable and pioneering residents who have shaped the identity and development of the City of Doral.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager, in coordination with the City Clerk, City Attorney, and relevant City departments, is hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Resolution. Implementation shall include, at minimum:

- (a) identifying and cataloguing existing City-owned art pieces, cultural artifacts, and historical documentation currently held by the City or in the custody of City departments;
- (b) engaging local cultural organizations, historical societies, Miami-Dade County Public Schools Doral-area campuses, and community stakeholders to contribute to the Archive's development;
- (c) exploring both digital and physical formats for the Archive, including potential exhibition space at the Miami-Dade Public Library System Doral Branch Library, Doral City Hall, and City parks facilities; and
- (d) presenting a proposed Archive framework and implementation timeline to the Mayor and City Council for review and approval.

The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
