

RESOLUTION No. 25-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO IMPLEMENT A MONTHLY “SENIOR SPLASH” PROGRAM AT THE DORAL AQUATIC CENTER EXCLUSIVELY FOR SILVER CLUB MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR SPECIALIZED AQUATIC FITNESS PROGRAMMING SUCH AS AQUA AEROBICS AND AQUA ZUMBA; AUTHORIZING A MONTHLY PROGRAM BUDGET OF UP TO ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$160.00); STATING THERE WILL BE NO IMPACT TO AQUATIC CENTER REVENUE; REQUIRING A SIX-MONTH PROGRAM REVIEW; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral is committed to enhancing the health, wellness, and social engagement of its senior residents; and

WHEREAS, the Silver Club provides recreational and enrichment opportunities for senior residents in Doral; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Rafael Pineyro has proposed a new monthly program titled “Senior Splash,” which would reserve hours at the Doral Aquatic Center exclusively for Silver Club members and provide no-cost access to senior-friendly aquatic fitness classes such as aqua aerobics and aqua Zumba; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the program is \$160 per month, and based on selected scheduling, it is anticipated there will be no revenue loss to the Aquatic Center; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Program Authorization. The City Manager is hereby directed to implement the “Senior Splash” program at the Doral Aquatic Center to provide monthly reserved hours exclusively for Silver Club members. These hours shall feature aquatic fitness programming, including but not limited to aqua aerobics and aqua Zumba.

Section 3. Budget Allocation. The City Manager is authorized to allocate up to \$160 per month to support the implementation of the program. This funding shall cover programming costs including instruction, staffing, and materials.

Section 4. Revenue Impact. The program shall be scheduled in such a way that it does not result in a loss of revenue to the Doral Aquatic Center, by selecting off-peak or low-traffic times for reserved use.

Section 5. Program Evaluation. The City Manager, or designee, shall conduct a review of the “Senior Splash” program after six (6) months of implementation. The review shall include data on participation, community feedback, and fiscal impact, and a report shall be submitted to the City Council for further consideration

Section 6. Implementation. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to take all necessary actions to implement, promote, and manage the “Senior Splash” program in a timely and efficient manner.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
