Current and former military members can appreciate convenient parking near your business. Set up parking space signs so this parking is available to these individuals.

The latex printed signs are rustproof. These signs are stable for outdoor use and endure many years in different weather.

Parking Space Signs are Laminated for Sturdiness

Include a protective laminate so your reflective signs are always legible to drivers. The lamination slides water and debris off surfaces.

The rustproof signs are made of aluminum for durability and sturdiness.

THE BASE

Option 1 – Portable Sign Base

- Aerodynamic, flexible, sturdy, stable and portable, this Standard Black Roll 'n' Pole Sign Holder helps you display a message anywhere you want. The unit does not require lifting or carrying - recessed wheels can be engaged by tipping the unit.
- Will never rust, discolor or need repainting.
- Bases have a ballast to increase weight and can be filled with sand, or gravel increasing the weight and allowing the unit to withstand winds of up to 40 mph. 3 feet are sculpted into the base and prevent the sign from rocking.
- Available with 4.25' and [5.25'](#) tall pole and in 4 color options: standard black, danger red, handicapped blue or safety yellow.
