ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH H&J ASPHALT, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF MILLING, RESURFACING, AND STRIPING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES WITHIN CITY SECTION 33, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED NINETY DOLLARS AND 71/100 (\$388,790.71) WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS; RECOGNIZING THAT H&J ASPHALT, INC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER, AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

On June 14, 2022, the existing contract for “Milling, Resurfacing and Miscellaneous Stormwater and Roadway Improvement” (ITB-2019-12) expired. Consequently, the Public Works Department (PWD) decided not to renew its option of two (2) one (1) year periods in the best interest of the City and its constituents. As a result, the PWD proceeded to fragment the all-encompassing scope of work of the previous contract to its new format of three (3) “scope specific” areas of construction.

On April 21, 2022, Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 2022-13 “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” was issued and advertised. A recommendation was made by the committee to award the top four (4) ranked firms, Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., H&R Paving, Inc., H&J Asphalt, Inc., and General Asphalt, establishing a Pool of Construction Firms for “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services”. The Continuing Service Agreements were approved by the Mayor and the City Councilmembers via Resolution No. 22-144 (approved 5-0), for an initial period of three (3) years with an option of two (2) one (1) year renewals.

The PWD requested a proposal from the “Pre-Qualified Pool of Contractors”, and H&J Asphalt, Inc. provided the lowest bid proposal for services which includes Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping within City Section 33. The PWD staff and H&J Asphalt, Inc. negotiated the

attached proposal in a not to exceed amount of \$388,790.71, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions.

The areas to be addressed within City Section 33 are:

- NW 23rd Street from 89th Place to 88th Court
- NW 21st Street from 88th Court to 87th Avenue
- NW 20th Street from 89th Place to 88th Court
- NW 88th Court from 18th Terrace to 23rd Street
