

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO WORK ORDER NO. 13 WITH MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. TO INCREASE THE AVAILABLE FUNDS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO COVER THE COST OF ADDITIONAL DESIGN AND PERMITTING SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CITYWIDE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS PHASE III PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS AND SEVENTY EIGHT CENTS (\$85,440.78); RECOGNIZING THAT MARLIN ENGINEERING INC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PREQUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AMENDMENT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in October 2023, the City of Doral (the “City”) Public Works Department (PWD) executed Work Order No. 13 with Marlin Engineering to provide design and permitting services for the Citywide Sidewalk Improvements Phase III project, and

WHEREAS, the Work Order No. 13 was approved via Resolution No. 23-177 and executed on a time and material basis in a not to exceed amount of One Hundred Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars and 00/100 (\$100,297.00); and

WHEREAS, the contract between Marlin and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Request for Qualification (RFQ) 2023-08 process to select a pool of pre-qualified continue professional services firms for roadway improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, this group of eleven (11) firms was approved by the City Council during the March 2024, Council meeting via Resolution No. 24-54; and

WHEREAS, during the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Electronic Review Comment (ERC) phase additional requests were made that require additional professional services hours and a work order amendment; and

WHEREAS, in order to cover the additional efforts resulting from the FDOT-ERC review, the City of Doral Public Works Department requested a proposal and negotiated with Marlin Engineering, the attached supplemental proposal on a time and material basis with a not to exceed amount of Eighty Five Thousand, Four Hundred Forty Dollars and 78/100 (\$85,440.78) for a new “amended” work order total amount of One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty Seven Dollars and 78/100 (\$185,737.78); and

WHEREAS, the PWD respectfully requests authorization from the Mayor and the City Councilmember to authorize the City Manager to execute the first amendment to Work Order no.13 enclosed as part of "Exhibit A" for “Citywide Sidewalk Improvements Phase III project to provide additional hours to cover FDOT requirements; and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available in the Public Transportation Fund – Construction in Progress, Account No. 101.80005.500650.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The first amendment to Work Order No. 13 between the City of Doral and Marlin Engineering Inc., to provide additional professional service hours associated with the design of the Citywide Sidewalk improvement phase III project, in an amount not to exceed Eighty Five Thousand, Four Hundred Forty Dollars and 78/100 (\$85,440.78), for a revised total work order amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty Seven Dollars and 78/100 (\$185,737.78), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
