BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction

The Police Department respectfully request authorization from Mayor and City Council members to seek access and utilize the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement (#198468) for Body Armor and Ballistic Resistant Product for the replacement of existing equipment and purchase for new hires from Federal Eastern International. The City is seeking a waiver of competitive bidding to access a competitively bidding contract with the State of Colorado. Seeking access to the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement the products would be local, readily accessible and at bid pricing.

Background

The Police Department respectfully request to purchase body armor products and ballistic resistant products from Federal Eastern International. The City is seeking to access the NASPO ValuePoint Master Agreement for Body Armor Products and Ballistic Resistant Product that's administered by the State of Colorado, via Master Agreement (#198468), which includes body armor products and ballistics resistant products (and any related services) in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds. The City of Doral Police Department has purchased body armor products and ballistic resistant products from Federal Eastern International in the past. Being a local vendor in the City of Doral they provide the services needed to personally outfit the products to the officers. Contract has been written in accordance with state regulations.

The body armors products and ballistic resistant products are essential body protection when responding to active shooter incidents, high risk calls and other incidents where there is a potential for gunfire.
