SPECIAL DETAILS AND EVENTS

Hurricane Safety

June 1st marked the onset of the 2025 Hurricane Season. The annual Hurricane Safety Fair was held at the City of Doral's Police Training and Community Center, located at 3719 NW 97th Avenue. The event invited our community to participate in a hurricane preparedness event. DPD was on site to help share vital information on how everyone can stay safe and be prepared.

Department-wide Semi-Annual Inspections

On June 1, 2025, all members of the DPD conducted formal line inspections to provide an accurate account of equipment issued to all members. Supervisors document each inspection on a Semi-Annual Inspection Form and forward each inspection through the Chain of Command for review.

Therapy K9 Milkshake

On Wednesday, June 4, 2025, the DPD introduced our newest therapy K9 during the City of Doral Council Meeting. Milkshake is a sweet addition to our team who was generously donated by the CPR Foundation and named in honor of the DPD's special partnership with Sloan's at City Place. Milkshake will join our first Therapy K9 Ginger to help bring comfort, compassion, and smiles to all they encounter.

End of 2024-2025 School Year

As the 2024-2025 school year ended, the DPD's School Resource Unit reflected on a successful school year marked by dedication, and a commitment to ensuring the safety and well-being of our students and faculty across all assigned schools. The Department recognized the efforts of all members of the School Resource Officer (SRO) Unit, Traffic Unit, and all DPD personnel who provided outstanding service and dedication, their tireless efforts and commitment to excellence have not gone unnoticed. Throughout the summer months, the SRO Unit continues to train, assist schools with summer programs, and provide security and safety throughout the City of Doral in preparation for the upcoming school year.

Parks and Police 4 Kids (PP4K) Summer Camp

The PP4K Foundation collaborates with the DPD to offer a summer camp for children at our city's newest park, Doral Central Park. The camp provides a variety of activities such as sports, teamwork, discipline, and empowers participants in a safe and empowering environment. The



PP4K Summer Camp is led by DPD SROs who spend quality time with our youth and mentor them along the way.

Narcotics Destruction and Burn 2025

The Doral Police Department's Property and Evidence Unit conducted a narcotics destruction during June 2025. Pursuant to Florida State Statute, the Department identified packages of narcotics that met the requirements set for destruction by law. Following a very detailed inventory and identification process, the identified items were inspected, packaged, and transported to the receiving facility where they were destroyed. This process was conducted with careful oversight and certification by several members of DPD, legal representatives, and a Miami-Dade Circuit Court Judge.

Traffic Safety and Enforcement

Traffic safety is crucial in the enhancement and overall safety of City of Doral residents and visitors. The DPD Traffic Section conducts traffic details based on data and areas of concern which have been identified to enforce traffic laws, reduce traffic crashes, assist with traffic direction and ensure public safety on the road. Throughout the month of June, the Traffic Section issued over 2,000 citations and the DPD issued over 4,000 citations. The DPDs goal is to increase police presence in areas which are prone to traffic crashes and instill safe driving practices.

Coffee with a Cop

On June 11, 2025, members of the DPD celebrated Father's Day with a Coffee, Cops & Dads event at the Intercontinental at Doral Miami Hotel. This event offered an amazing opportunity for members of the community to speak with our DPD Police Officers and continue to build upon our partnerships. These events are very successful and bring all participating together for an opportunity to share in conversation with no agenda or speeches, just a chance to ask questions, voice concerns or simply get to know your local police officers better.
