ITEM TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS RFP #2026-08 "COLLISION REPAIR AND BODY WORK SERVICES" TO WORLD MOTOR CORPORATION AND TO CAR WORLD PAINT AND BODY SHOP, FOR A TERM OF THREE (3) YEARS WITH TWO (2) ONE (1) YEAR OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR A TOTAL TERM OF FIVE (5) YEARS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SERVICE AGREEMENT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The City of Doral ("City") Department of Public Works and Department of Procurement and Asset Management prepared RFP No. 2026-08 to identify one or more qualified and experienced firms to provide Collision Repair and Body Work Services. The scope of services generally entails Collision Repair and Body Work Services for all types and sizes of City automobiles, trucks, heavy equipment, and vans. Services include the repair, replacement, adjustment and/or overhaul of minor and major components such as safety equipment, suspension, steering, electrical, and other areas damaged in a collision.

On April 10, 2026, the City of Doral issued RFP No. 2026-08 inviting all qualified and experienced firms to submit proposals for Collision Repair and Body Work Services. Notices were posted on the City's website, and through our Open Gov procurement platform with electronic broadcast to numerous vendors.

On May 4, 2026, the City received and opened Five (5) timely proposals from the following respondents:

- Advanced Body and Frame, Inc.
- Car World Paint and Body Shop
- Enterprises of Miami LLC
- National Collision and Truck Center
- World Motor Corp

On May 28, 2026, the Phase I Evaluation Committee meeting was conducted, and the following firms were ranked as the top two: Car World Paint and Body Shop and World Motor Corp. The Committee agreed that a phase II evaluation was not needed and the consensus was to award our Collision Repair and Body Work Services RFP to the two (2) top ranked firms.

Based on the thorough evaluation conducted by the Committee, the highest scoring proposal was Car World Paint and Body Shop with the second being World Motor Corp.

Section 5.1.4 of RFP No. 2026-08 provides as follows:

“After reviewing the Committee’s scores and ranking as well as the administrative review conducted by Procurement staff, the City Manager may take any action in the City’s best interest, which may include but is not limited to the following:

- make a recommendation to award to Council,
- may reject the Committee’s scoring in whole or in part,
- may require the Committee to re-evaluate or
- may reject all proposals.”
