Subject: **Adopt-a-Street Application – The Mora-Roman Family**

### **Introduction**

As part of the City of Doral “Keep Doral Beautiful” campaign, the Public Works Department (PWD) established the “Adopt-a-Street” program in 2005. It provides the opportunity for volunteer groups to clean and remove litter from the City’s public right-of-way at least four (4) times a year for a period of two (2) years. The Program provides the option to automatically renew the agreement if the applicant adheres to the Program requirements. The total weight amount of garbage collected by the volunteers is reported on a yearly basis to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) as part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

### **Background**

The Mora-Roman Family have been residents of Doral for over 20 years. The Family takes great pride of Doral, and it is shown on their commitment by conducting more cleanups than required by the volunteer program. They fulfilled their requirements in 2018 and in 2021.

### **Fiscal Impact:**

The fiscal impact associated with the program is less than \$50,000, no further analysis is required.

This initiative is aligned with the Exceptional Service Strategic Goal, as it provides the opportunity to build a strong sense of community.

**Recommendation**
