## **RESOLUTION No. 25-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, SITTING AS THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL / DENIAL OF, OR GOING FORWARD WITHOUT A RECOMMENDATION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY, AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 68, ARTICLE III OF THE CITY OF DORAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLED "OFFICE DISTRICTS"; CREATING SECTION 68-307 TITLED "TANDEM PARKING IN MIXED USE DEVELOPMENTS"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Chapter 68, Article III of the City of Doral (the "City") Code of Ordinances provides for land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it is advisable for these rules to be reviewed and revised as necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, given the increase in parking demands in certain mixed-use developments, it is desirable to allow for tandem parking to be allowed in a limited capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council believe that these changes are in the City's best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, SITTING AS THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Decision.</u> The LPA hereby recommends <u>approval/denial or going</u> <u>forward without a recommendation</u> to the local governing body (City Council) the following amendment to the City's Code:

Amending Chapter 68 Article III of the City of Doral Code of Ordinances Titled "Commercial Districts"; Creating Section 68-307 Titled "Tandem Parking in Mixed Use Developments"

## Sec. 63-387. Tandem Parking in Mixed Use Developments

The city recognizes that public parking demand in the City of Doral is continuing to increase as development and redevelopment occurs.

In order to address the demand of parking needs in mixed use developments, that are geographically located on the Southern end of N.W. 41<sup>st</sup> Street, commonly referred to as Doral Boulevard, West of 97<sup>th</sup> Avenue, East of 102<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and North of 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, and that are no less than fifteen (15) acres, the City will permit the use of tandem parking, provided that all other sections of the City Code are complied with.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Local Planning Agency.
