

RESOLUTION No. 26-

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE WORK ORDER NO. 6 WITH CHA CONSULTING, INC. (CHA) FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO THE DESIGN AND PERMITTING OF MIDBLOCK CROSSWALKS WITH RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACONS (RRFB's) AT FOUR (4) SEPARATE LOCATIONS, BASED ON A PREVIOUSLY APPROVED TRAFFIC STUDY RECOMMENDING TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THESE LOCATIONS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FORTY ONE DOLLARS AND NINE CENTS (\$69,941.09); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") Public Works Department ("PWD") needs to secure a firm to provide the services identified for the project entitled "Midblock Crosswalk Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon" (RRFB) at four (4) separate locations; and

WHEREAS, a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) is a pedestrian-activated warning device with bright, yellow, rectangular LED lights that flash in a rapid, irregular pattern to alert drivers to people crossing at uncontrolled mid-block crosswalks, significantly improving driver yielding rates and making crossings safer; and

WHEREAS, in October of 2025, the PWD requested a proposal from CHA to provide professional services for the design and permitting phase of Midblock Crosswalk Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon" at four (4) separate locations; and

WHEREAS, this project covers the design and permitting phase at four Mid-block crosswalk locations: NW 58th Street at Doral Meadow Creek Park, NW 78th Street east of NW 107th Avenue, NW 82nd Street east of NW 107th Avenue and NW 88th Street east of NW 107th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, work will include milling and resurfacing, installation of concrete sidewalks and driveways, ADA curb ramps, signage, pavement markings, and installation of RRFB at each location; and

WHEREAS, CHA Consulting Inc. (CHA) is a pre-qualified provider of professional engineering services selected by Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council on June 3, 2024, via Resolution 24-54; and

WHEREAS, the contract between CHA Consulting, Inc. (CHA) and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Invitation to Bid (ITB) 2023-08 process to select a pool of pre-qualified Engineering and Architecture firms; and

WHEREAS, this group of eleven (11) firms was approved by the Mayor and City Councilmembers during the March 2024 Council meeting via Resolution No. 24-54; and

WHEREAS, the PWD respectfully requests authorization from the Mayor and the City Councilmember to authorize the City Manager to execute Work Order No. 6 enclosed as part of "Exhibit A" for design and permitting phase to Midblock Crosswalk Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon" at four (4) separate locations, in an amount not to exceed Sixty Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty One Dollars and 09/100 (\$69,941.09); and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available in the Public Stormwater Fund – Construction in Progress, Account No. 101.80005.500650.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The work Order No. 6 between the City of Doral and CHA Consulting Inc. to provide the design and permitting phase “Midblock Crosswalk Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon” at four (4) separate locations in an amount not to exceed Sixty Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty One Dollars and 09/100 (\$69,941.09), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council’s intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
