



## **CITY OF DORAL COUNCIL MEETING MEMORANDUM**

### **ITEM TITLE:**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDED REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS #2025-06 "STORM DRAIN AND RIGHT-OF-WAY REPAIR SERVICES" TO A PRE-QUALIFIED POOL OF CONTRACTORS TO PROVIDE MISCELLANEOUS STORM DRAIN AND RIGHT-OF-WAY REPAIR SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS, WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO (2) ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR PERIODS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENTS AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

### **DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION:**

### **BRIEF HISTORY:**

On August 9, 2025, the existing contract for "Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services" (ITB-2022-14) expired. Consequently, the Public Works Department (PWD) decided not to renew its option of two (2) one (1) year periods in the best interest of the City and its constituents.

The Public Works Department and the Procurement and Asset Management Department, prepared RFQ No. 2025-06 to solicit qualified and experienced professional services firms in the field of Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services. The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract, through open, competitive qualifications, for providing miscellaneous Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services for City Facilities for a three (3) year contract period, with the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods.

The City issued RFQ No. 2025-06 on May 2, 2025, inviting qualified firms to submit proposal responses. The notice was published on the City's website, VendorRegistry.com, and Demandstar.com, and distributed electronically to a wide network of vendors. A publicly noticed, non-mandatory pre-bid conference was held on May 19, 2025.

On June 20, 2025, the City received and publicly opened six (6) timely proposals from the following respondents:

- C&W Pipeline, Inc.
- Metro Express, Inc.

- Pimentel Construction Group
- Quality Paving Corp.
- Star Paving Corporation
- The Stout Group, LLC

During the initial review by the Procurement Department, all six proposals were deemed responsive to the RFQ requirements. Upon completion of the Procurement Department's due diligence, the responsive proposals were provided to each of the Evaluation Committee Members selected by the City Manager to evaluate, rank and provide an award recommendation for RFQ-2025-06.

The Evaluation Committee members assigned by the City Manager included:

- Julio Amoedo, Chief of Construction, Public Works
- Darlin Perez, Chief of Engineering, Public Works
- Danilo Brito, Chief Plumbing Inspector, Building

On June 30, 2025, the Evaluation Committee, convened in a public Evaluation Committee Meeting whereby they discussed all 6 proposals and unanimously recommended for all six proposers to be prequalified under RFQ-2025-06.

It should be noted that the construction work will be performed via work orders awarded based on the lowest proposer from the pool of contractors. Work Orders exceeding the City Manager's approval threshold will be presented at Council Meetings for approval.
