Fiscal Impact Statement: The proposed item will have a fiscal impact on flood insurance policyholders in the Special Flood Hazard Areas (SFHA) at a point in the future but is unknown at the State, Regional and Local levels as a result of Florida SB 180. Whereas the city participates in the voluntary Community Rating System (CRS) program under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and is currently rated a Class 6 Community where policyholders enjoy a 20% discount on flood insurance premiums in the SFHA and whereas the removal of Cumulative Substantial Improvement afforded points in the CRS and has been summarily removed by the state legislature, the effects of which are unknown at this time.
