A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID PROCESS PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-321 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS WITH CENTRAL SQUARE FOR CAD, CRIME VIEW AND CRYWOLF FOR RECURRING ANNUAL MAINTENANCE SOFTWARE AND LICENSE FEES; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS IN FURTHERANCE HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction

The Police Department is respectfully requesting the Mayor and City Council to approve expenditures to pay Central Square for annual maintenance fees for OSSI/SunGard/Superion, Crime View and Crywolf (licenses/software's). The Police Department is seeking a waiver of competitive bidding.

Background

On July 22, 2020, Resolution No. 20-138 authorized the City Manager to expend funds for the annual maintenance of the SunGard Public Sector Software maintenance for software that provided a Computer Aided Dispatch System (CAD); Records Management System (RMS); and Ticket-Writing Personal Digital Assistants (PDA's). The Police Department is requesting that the bid process be waived for Central Square Technologies in order to pay the software maintenance fees and continue doing business, as they are now a one-stop shop for the Doral Police Department's CAD and RMS Platform.

Central Square Technologies was formed by the merger of SunGard (Superion-CAD), Trittech Software (Crime View) and Public Safety Corporation (Crywolf). Central Square's CAD application software interfaces with Crime View and Crywolf, which are currently in use by the Doral Police Department. Using a different vendor will require different applications that do not interface with our current system. Central Square Technologies periodically update

their software to ensure their platforms run as designed and make sure that the Doral Police Department can perform its job in serving the Doral Community effectively.

There is no other vendor that will correctly interface with existing equipment. Central Square is named in the GovTech 100 list as the major public sector software provider. They have secured a spot on this list for eight consecutive years (2016-2026), recognized for its public safety and administrative technology. They partner with more than 8,000 public sector agencies across North America.

Therefore, the Police Department respectfully requests the following:

- the procurement competitive bidding procedure requirements be waived; and
- we be authorized to expend budgeted funds with Central Square for the annual software maintenance fees of the various software programs we currently have (CAD, Crime View and CryWolf) with 18 years of valuable data.

The funds will be allocated from the IT Repair and Maintenance– Office Equipment Account (#001.22005.500464) or any other appropriate accounts in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds.
