

**RESOLUTION No. 26-**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE USE OF FLORIDA STATE CONTRACT No. 56120000-24-NY-ACS, WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY'S CODE, FOR THE PURCHASE OF OFFICE FURNITURE FOR ALL CITY FACILITIES TO BE USED BY ALL CITY DEPARTMENTS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY'S CODE, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO UTILIZE THE MENTIONED CONTRACT AND SUBSEQUENT RENEWALS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ANNUAL BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, as the City of Doral (the "City") continues to grow, there is a need for the City's Facilities to adapt and transform in order to address the needs of a growing staff and ensure that the best possible service is provided to the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, through its Public Works Department, Capital Improvements Division, Parks and Recreation Department, Police Department, and the Procurement and Asset Management Department have ongoing and planned construction and interior renovation projects at City Facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the scope of work for all projects includes purchasing of new office and recreational furniture for renovated areas and new spaces; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to be able to place a furniture order immediately when the construction or renovation plans are released; and

**WHEREAS**, to address this matter and be able to procure the office furniture at the discounted government price City staff recommend that the City Council approve

and authorize the City Manager to proceed with the purchase of any City needed office furniture, that was approved in the annual budget without having to go back to council for approval, as long as it is being purchased from the State Contract NO. 56120000-24-NY-ACS, which was competitively entered into in a matter similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V of the City Code, in an amount not to exceed departmental budgeted funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

**Section 2. Approval.** The purchase of any City needed office furniture, that was approved in the annual budget, without having to go back to council for approval, as long as it being purchased from the State Contract NO. 56120000-24-NY-ACS, which was competitively entered into in a matter similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V of the City Code, is hereby approved.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreements and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

**Section 4. Implementation.** The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
