BRIEF HISTORY:

The ULPBC-USJP has been a federally funded program with activities for over 50 years. The goal of USJP is to help unemployed participants age 55+ develop skills that improve their ability to find work.

The USJP is a senior initiative offered locally by the Urban League in Broward and Miami-Dade counties. They work with their participants to hone their skills, maintain job readiness, and find the right opportunities. USJP maintains a pool of qualified workers to ensure participants meet the requirements sought by organizations that are actively hiring. Each participant will be tailored to their specific interests and work requirements.

Becoming a host agency will provide the City with temporary additional manpower to strengthen the programs and services we provide to the community. Additionally, this program will provide seniors with an opportunity to gain meaningful work experience and be compensated through ULPBC-USJP for the hours they work per week. Seniors that participate will be matched with work assignments based on their skills, experience, knowledge and abilities, and will be utilized on an as needed basis.
