BRIEF HISTORY:

In 2024, the City of Doral's residents voted in favor of creating the office of the Inspector General. The City of Doral's Mayor and City Council are among the few governmental bodies that have created prescriptive rules that govern their professionalism and behavior that are encoded into the City's Code of Ordinances.

This high standard has been for the most part self-regulated. However, unlike other sections of the City's Code, violations of the rules of procedure and conduct are not regulated by the City's Code Enforcement Department. Also, there are no penalties for violation of the rules of procedure or conduct. Accordingly, it is desirable that the Inspector General be authorized as a City official to conduct investigations, and where necessary, citations to violators of the City's Council code of conduct and procedure.
