The Commission on the Status of Women respectfully requests your consideration and approval to host a women's development event focused on both professional and personal growth within our community.

The official name of the event is currently being finalized, the concept centers on a comprehensive "360° Women's Development" experience designed to support the advancement, well-being and empowerment of women through education, connection and access to meaningful resources.
