BRIEF HISTORY:

Introduction:

The Police Department is seeking approval from the Mayor and City Council members to adopt and utilize the existing contract with Florida Sheriff's Association Cooperative Purchasing Program Contract number FSA23-EQU21.1:Equipment Extension Packet to purchase any and all equipment including all terrain and utility vehicles under this contract from any of the awarded vendors mentioned therein in an amount not to exceed budgeted funds. The City is seeking a waiver of competitive bidding.

Background:

The Police Department is requesting the approval to purchase any necessary equipment, including all-terrain and utility vehicles, as needed to maintain operational efficiency throughout the City; and further authorizing such purchases in accordance with the Florida Sheriff's Association Cooperative Purchasing Program Contract No. FSA23-EQU21.1:Equipment Extension Packet, permitting procurement from any of the awarded vendors listed therein.
