A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL SPONSORSHIPS TO EAG FOUNDATION IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$750.00); LATIN AMERICAN FOUNDATION INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$1,000.00); AND THE MEXICAN CULTURAL AND TOURISM INSTITUTE OF HOUSTON (MCTIH) IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$1,200.00); PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-79 OF THE CITY'S CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

The EAG Foundation is a Doral-founded nonprofit organization created by a local student with a mission to inspire and incentivize young people to volunteer their time to support individuals in need. The organization promotes youth-led service initiatives, encourages civic responsibility, and mobilizes volunteers to gather essential resources for vulnerable populations both locally and abroad, including communities in Colombia.

EAG is also dedicated to supporting underprivileged athletes by donating athletic gear, including new and gently used sportswear, footwear, and equipment. Through monetary contributions and in-kind donations, the Foundation ensures that aspiring athletes who may lack access to proper gear can fully participate in sports and recreational activities that foster personal growth, physical health, and teamwork.

The Foundation's commitment to volunteerism, youth empowerment, and humanitarian outreach aligns with the City of Doral's mission and strategic priorities, particularly those focused on community engagement, youth development, and support for charitable initiatives that improve the wellbeing of residents.
