A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCESS TIPS CONTRACT 230105 TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS PRODUCTS AND SERVICES PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY OF DORAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, FOR THE RENEWAL OF MICROSOFT PRODUCTS AND LICENSES THROUGH THE CLOUD SOLUTION PROVIDER (CSP) PROGRAM ON A YEARLY BASIS WITH UNITED DATA TECHNOLOGIES INC. (UDT); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City relies on Microsoft products and licenses to support critical productivity, security, and collaboration tools across all departments; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EA) is set to expire, requiring renewal to ensure continued and uninterrupted service delivery; and

WHEREAS, after evaluation, the Cloud Solution Provider (CSP) program provides significant benefits over the EA, including annual renewal flexibility, scalability to adjust licenses as staffing levels and needs change, streamlined management and billing, and continued access to Microsoft 365, Azure, and advanced security services; and

WHEREAS, transitioning to the CSP program enhances the City's ability to modernize IT service delivery, strengthen security, protect information, and align with broader technology initiatives, thereby improving public trust, resilience, and service to residents; and

WHEREAS, notably, Section 119.0725 (b), Florida Statutes, creates a public records exemption related to cybersecurity. Specifically, the statute makes any

information related to critical infrastructure such as this confidential and exempt from public record requirements. In addition to the public records exemption, any portion of a meeting that might reveal such information is exempt from public meeting requirements. See Section 119.0725(3), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-322 of the City Code of Ordinances provides that the Council may enter into contracts procured by other public entities and cooperative purchasing ventures. Accordingly, the City may solicit the goods and services provided by vendors participating in TIPS contract 230105 Technology Solutions Products and Services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Manager's Office respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council Members authorize the use of TIPS contract 230105, Technology Solutions Products and Services, to renew Microsoft products and licenses through the cloud solution provider (CSP) program on a yearly basis with United Data Technologies Inc. (UDT), not to exceed the budgeted funds. Funds allocated in the IT Maintenance Account # 001.22005.500460.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.
