A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDED INVITATION TO NEGOTIATE ITN #2026-11 "VENDING MACHINES OPERATION & MANAGEMENT" TO FRESH SERVICE & REPAIR CORPORATION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FRESH SERVICE & REPAIR CORPORATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW FOR TWO (2) ONE (1) YEAR PERIODS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") through its Parks and Recreation and Procurement and Asset Management Departments, issued Invitation to Negotiate (ITN) No. 2026-11 to solicit proposals from qualified service providers for vending machines; and

WHEREAS, the ITN solicitation was advertised and issued by the City on April 1, 2026, and the City received three (3) proposals, in which three (3) were deemed complete and responsive; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee, approved by the City Manager held a public meeting on May 12, 2026, and the responsive proposers were reviewed and ranked; and

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the meeting, the Committee unanimously agreed to invite the top three (3) ranked proposers for presentations and Q&A session; and

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the meeting, the Committee unanimously agreed to invite the top two (2) ranked proposers to the negotiation phase; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2026, the Evaluation Committee convened to conduct negotiations with the top two (2) finalists to facilitate discussions and prepare the finalists for submission of their Best and Final Offers (“BAFOs”); and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2026, the Evaluation Committee convened in a public meeting conduct to evaluate and rank the BAFOs, upon completion of the review, the Evaluation Committee ranked the two finalists as follows:

1. Fresh Service & Repair Corporation
2. Compass Group USA, Inc. by and through its Canteen Division

WHEREAS, after consideration of the Evaluation Committee’s recommendation, the City Council determined that it is in the best interest of the City to award Invitation to Negotiate (ITN) No. 2026-11 “Vending Machines Operations & Management” to Fresh Service & Repair Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Invitation to Negotiate (ITN) No. 2026-11 “Vending Machines Operations & Management” is awarded to Fresh Service & Repair Corporation.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreements and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to take any additional actions necessary to implement this Resolution, including making any modifications, executing any documents and addendums as necessary to effectuate this Resolution, provided that such actions remain consistent with the Council's intent.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
