DPD Park Patrol Unit

Annual Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Event, May 1, 2025

The Law Enforcement Officers Memorial was established in 1980 to honor fallen officers from every police department and law enforcement agency within Miami-Dade County. The memorial is located within Tropical Park and contains four granite walls etched with the names of the brave men and women who died serving the citizens of their communities. The Police Officers Assistance Trust (POAT) hosts an annual memorial event, where family, friends and colleagues come together to honor and remember our fallen brothers and sisters. Members of the Doral Police Department, including Honor Guard and Motor Officers, reverently gathered alongside other law enforcement agencies to honor their sacrifice.

On Saturday, May 17, 2025, Sergeant Andre Romo and Officer Ricardo Acevedo were awarded the 2025 South Florida PBA Officer of the Year Award for their response during the mass shooting incident at Martini Bar, City Place Doral on April 6, 2024. Sergeant Romo and Officer Acevedo responded immediately and courageously confronted the armed subject, ending the subject's rage of gunfire and ultimately neutralizing the threat. During the incident Officer Acevedo was injured in the shooting, two people were killed and seven were injured.
