



CITY OF DORAL COUNCIL MEETING MEMORANDUM MAYOR AND COUNCIL

ITEM TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ARTICLE VII OF CHAPTER 44, TITLED "MICRO-MOBILITY DEVICES"; RELATED TO THE REGULATION OF MICRO-MOBILITY DEVICES; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION INTO THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BRIEF HISTORY:

During the October 2025 Council Meeting, the City of Doral became the first municipality in Miami-Dade County to pass legislation regulating the use of micro-mobility devices on the City's rights-of-way. Subsequent to the legislations passage, the City held a regional, micro-mobility conference with local municipalities in order to discuss the City's legislation, to listen to other municipalities concerns regarding regulation of micromobility devices, and to discover additional policies that could enhance the City's legislation.

As a result of the workshop, the City learned that other municipalities were requiring the registration of micro-mobility devices operating in municipal rights-of-way. The registration process allows the municipality to ensure that the micromobility device is meeting the City's regulation, provide for education on safety, and provide for greater regulation of these devices.

The addition of a registration requirement is in the City's best interest and will advance public safety.
